NOTES & Membership Class Definitions

NOTE 1 Member (Full)

Membership of the Chelmsford Society of Model Engineers Limited (the Company) is available to those aged 18 years and older. Prospective members must fill in the form on the front of this document. On receipt of the completed form and fee due the Membership Secretary will notify you if your application has been accepted. Following approval such persons become members of the Company for one year (or until the end of the club year, whichever is sooner) and have the right to vote at Company and other meetings. They are insured to take part in all club activities.

NOTE 2 Honorary Members

Honorary members are covered by the same requirements and rules as Members but the membership fee is currently NIL.

NOTE 3 Junior Members - Persons under 18 years of age

Persons who are not yet old enough to seek membership of the Company may enrol as Junior Model Engineers. Where they are under the age of 16 years they must be accompanied, while they are on site, by a parent or guardian who is a FULL member of the Company

A Junior Model Engineer over 16 years of age may be on site without a parent or guardian provided there are five or more full members on site. In this case there is no need for the person's parent or guardian to be a member.

In both cases the responsible parent or guardian must fill out the form on the front of this document to indicate that they accept the rules on behalf of the junior member.

Junior Model Engineers will not have voting rights. Those under 16 years of age may not drive a vehicle or locomotive hauling the public. With this exception they are insured to take part in club activities. Membership is for the current club year.

NOTE 4 Associate Members

A Member (or Honorary Member) may include one related person on his / her membership application form such that the person receives insurance cover, with the insurance fee paid by the society. The insurance is to cover carrying out general duties and this is not to extend to driving vehicles or locomotives with members of the public as passengers. Such persons do not have voting rights.

NOTE 5 Extended Associate Member

This class of membership is the same as Associate except that the driving of vehicles or locomotives with members of the public as passengers is allowed and covered by the company insurance. It is open to **active** Associate members. Prospective Extended Associate Members must complete the appropriate form and send or give it to the membership secretary for acceptance.

NOTE 6 General Data Protection Regulations 2018 - CSME Statement

Data Processing - The data you provide by filling in this form will not be processed in anyway and nor will it be communicated to any party outside CSME

Data Collection and storage – The only personal data collected by CSME is that which you provide by filling in the form attached. In the first instance it will be stored by the Membership Secretary. It will also be stored in the form of a mailing list by the magazine team. E-mail addresses are also listed and stored separately, currently by John Dalton. If you fail to apply for membership renewal within three months of the due date your data will be removed and your membership will be cancelled.

Data Uses – The basic name and address data is used to identify you as a paid up member. The mailing list has been note above. While your telephone number is not essential it does enable the society to contact you if, say, an event has been cancelled. Similarly an e-mail address allows a quick means of communicating society information. If you **do not wish** to receive e-mails or telephone calls, do not provide this information. Your indication of a willingness to help with Sunday running is used to produce the roster.

If someone contacts the data holder with a wish to contact you, you will be informed and you will be left to make contact if you so wish.

Your Rights - You have the right to see what data is held and request changes. You may request that all data is removed but if the society has no record of you it is hard to see how you can be a member. You have a right to make a formal complaint if you feel that your data is misused.
